What to do if	Action needed	Return to school when
 My child has any Covid-19 symptoms: High temperature A new continuous cough A loss or change to sense of smell or taste 	Do not come to school Contact school to inform us. Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days. Get a test. Inform school immediately of the test result.	they feel better <u>and</u> at least 10 days have passed since symptoms started, even if they still have a cough or a loss/change in sense of taste or smell. These symptoms may last for several weeks after recovery from illness.
My child tests positive for Covid-19	Do not come to school Contact school to inform us. Agree an earliest date for possible return to school (minimum of 10 days from day after when symptoms started). Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days.	they feel better and at least 10 days have passed since the symptoms started, even if they still have a cough or a loss/change in sense of taste or smell. These symptoms may last for several weeks after recovery from illness.
My child tests negative for Covid-19	Contact the school. Discuss when your child can come back to school.	the test comes back negative and they fell well and are clear of any other signs of illness.
My child is ill with symptoms not linked to Covid-19	Follow usual school absence procedure	they are recovered, as usual.
Someone in my household has Covid-19 symptoms	Do not come to school Contact school to inform us. Household member to get tested, and the whole household should self-isolate until the result comes. Inform school immediately of the test result.	the test comes back negative and your child feels well and is free of any signs of illness.
Someone in my household tests positive for Covid-19	Do not come to school Contact school to inform us. Agree an earliest date for possible return to school (minimum of 14 days from day after when household member's symptoms started). Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days.	the student has completed 14 full days of isolation
NHS Test & Trace identifies that my child has been in close contact with someone with Covid-19	Do not come to school Contact school to inform us. Agree an earliest date for possible return to school (minimum of 14 days). The individual contacted by Test & Trace should maintain distance from other household members as far as possible for 14 days.	the student has completed 14 full days of isolation
