

JCoSS Admissions Appeals Timetable 2026/27

If your application for a place at JCoSS is unsuccessful, you have a right to appeal to an independent Appeals Panel. Each appeal is decided on the individual circumstances of the case. Please be aware that as the school is likely to be oversubscribed, only exceptional circumstances are likely to result in a successful appeal.

The timetable for appeals is as follows for 2026:

	National offer day	Application to Appeal deadline	Appeals heard
Year 7 2026	2 nd March 2026	5 th May 2026	June 2026
In Year and 6th Form Admissions			Within 30 school days of appeal being lodged

In line with national regulations for School Admissions, the following should be noted:

- Appeals will be heard within 30 school days of the deadline for lodging appeals.
- For late applications, appeals will be heard within 40 school days of the deadline for lodging appeals where possible, or within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged.
- You will be given 10 statutory days notice of your appeal hearing.
- You will be sent a copy of the school's statement, admissions policy and names of the panel members at least 7 days prior to your hearing.
- You will be given a deadline for submitting further evidence. Information received after the deadline may not be considered by the panel.
- You can not submit any additional evidence after your appeal hearing has taken place.
- Decision letters will be sent within 5 school days of the hearing wherever possible.
